Call to Worship:

Leader: Before the throne there was something that looked like a sea of glass, clear like crystal. In the center and around the throne were four living creatures with eyes all over them, in front and in back. Each of these four living creatures had six wings and was covered all over with eyes, inside and out. Day and night they never stop saying:

People: **"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty. He was, he is, and he is coming."**

**Lord, come to us in our darkness, and give us your light of love and mercy. Open our eyes to the good news of your eternal glory. Give us visions of the place in which love and hope will reign. Forgive our stubborn resistance to your mercy and love, for we ask in Jesus' name.**

Assurance of Pardon:

Leader: If you make the Most High your dwelling--even the LORD, who is my refuge--then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent. People: **Since I have made the LORD my dwelling place,  
Home of my care and harbor of my praise;  
Great hosts of angels, messengers of grace,  
God sends to keep me safe in all my ways.**

Leader: "Because he loves me," says the LORD, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name. He will call upon me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him. With long life will I satisfy him and show him my salvation."

People: **"For I, the LORD, have bound you safe in love,  
You need not fear, I will your rescue be."  
Since Thou, O LORD, from danger me remove,  
My song shall be Thy praise eternally.**


