Invitation to the Lord's Table

Leader: Sisters and brothers, this is the joyful feast of the people of God! They will come from north and south and from east and west to sit at table in the kingdom of God. According to Luke, when our risen Lord was at table with his disciples, he took the bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. Then their eyes were opened, and they recognized him. This is the Lord's table. . . .

Love is always preparing a table –

People: **no detail overlooked, no element inconsequential.**

Leader: In the presence of enemies, in the valley of the shadow —

People: **even there, Love goes boldly ahead of us, comforting us and keeping us safe.**

Leader: In the midst of circumstances, Love says, "Sit down and eat" —

People: **and goodness and mercy sit down beside us; they are capable of nothing less.**

Leader: Love has prepared this table —

People: **thanks be to God, there is room for every guest.**

Breaking the Bread

Leader: On the very night he would be betrayed, Jesus gathered his friends around him at a table. He picked up the bread that was on the table. And what did he do with it?

People: He said, "This cup is the cup of the New Covenant. It is sealed in my blood and shed for the forgiveness of sins. Every time you drink of it, do so in remembrance of me."

Leader: Let us now share the cup with one another.

Closing Prayer:

Leader: God of grace, you renew us at your table with the bread of life and the cup of salvation. May this food strengthen us in love and help us to serve you in each other. We ask this in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord.

People: Amen.

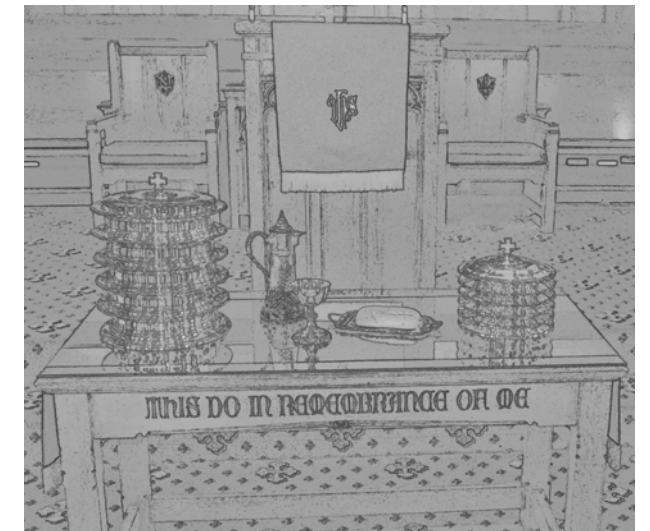
